

NOTICE OF PESTICIDE APPLICATION

This notice is being provided to you as required by the NJ Integrated Pest Management Act of 2002 to inform you of the planned application of herbicides on school grounds. Applications of a selective herbicide (weed killer) will be made to selected grass athletic fields at the high school, 160 Mansfield Road; The application of herbicide will commence on Wednesday, August 3rd and continue daily for up to five consecutive week days, weather permitting. There will be a posting at the school entrances on the day when the applications will occur.

All Material Safety Data Sheets for the chemicals that will be applied are available for your inspection in the office of the Facilities Director located in the high school and at the middle school facility supervisor's office..

The Office of Pesticide Programs of the United States Environmental Protection Agency has stated: "Where possible, persons who potentially are sensitive, such as pregnant women, infants, and children, should avoid any unnecessary pesticide exposure."

Location of the pesticide applications: The applications will be limited to high school athletic fields #9, 19, 21, and 26. The applications will not disrupt campus activities.

Herbicide: Prosedge Selective Herbicide™ -- Used to control listed broadleaf weeds and nutsedge in turf grasses (established lawns) landscaped areas, public recreation areas, golf courses, school grounds, sod or turf seed farms, sports fields,tennis courts, campgrounds and rights-of-way.

Reason for the pesticide application:

Normal, maintenance practices of the grounds department as part of the routine summer program of maintaining school grass athletic fields. This herbicide is specifically targeted for actively growing weeds on the school district athletic fields. To be applied by a licensed district buildings/grounds employee.

In the case of an outdoor application, 3 dates must be listed, in chronological order, on which the outdoor application may take place if the preceding date is canceled.

Description of the possible adverse effects of the pesticides as per the Material Safety Data Sheets for the pesticides to be used, if available:

Prosege Selective Herbicide™-- Moderate eye irritation based on toxicity studies; minimally toxic and slightly irritating to the skin; moderately toxic if ingested; low toxicity if inhaled.

Pesticide(s) product-label instructions and precautions related to Public Safety:

Prosege Selective Herbicide™ -- Keep out of reach of children. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift.
